### **Tips for Successful Video Calls**

**Remember:** Video calls like Zoom are **public** spaces. This means that other people can see or hear what we do, say, and show.

## Find a good space to be in while you are on the call. A good space...

- Is quiet.
- Has a background that is not distracting.
- Has appropriate lighting. It is not too dark or too bright.

#### Wear appropriate clothing.

• Dress for the audience (e.g. work vs. church vs. talking with friends).

#### Check your internet connection.

 Try moving to a different spot if the connection is not strong.

# Make sure you can hear others and they can hear you.

• Test your microphone and speakers before a call.

#### Make sure others can see you.

- Test your camera before a call.
- Test the angle of your camera to make sure your head (and shoulders, if possible) can be seen.

### Pay attention.

- Avoid distracting behaviors.
- Be a good listener.
- Take turns talking.
- Use the chat box if needed.
